HB 2042 (Effective Sept. 1, 2019)



Section 2

- Changes TX Govt Code, Section 2101.011(c)
 - Replaces detailed statement with information
 - Removes consumable supplies/postage
 - Removes "All Other Assets"

Section 3

- Changes TX Govt Code, Section 2101.012(b)
 - Removes requirement to comply with GAAP and AICPA
 - Allows the Comptroller's office to request reporting information in a manner that allows for the faster CAFR initiative





- Affects only SRAs (at this time)
- Does NOT affect FRAs (at this time)
- Does NOT affect stand-alone audited AFRs

SRA – Important Dates

- Sept. 10, 2019 notify your financial reporting analyst which option your agency is taking:
 Option 1 vs. Option 2
- Sept. 14, 2019 enter your investment/bank transaction activity into USAS
- Sept. 30, 2019 complete APS 018 entries into USAS





Complete closing package & submit to the Comptroller's Financial Reportion section at FRS@cpa.texas.gov by COB on **Sept. 15, 2019**

- > Physical inventory of capital & controlled assets certification by Sept. 20, 2019
- > DINSS Enter data, upload Note 3 and certify by COB on Sept. 28, 2019
- > LTLN Upload Note 5
- ➤ LNSS Upload Note 8
- > SEFA Enter federal revenues and pass-through activity
 - USAS COB on Sept. 26, 2019
 - Web apps COB on Sept. 28, 2019
 - Certify by COB on Sept. 28, 2019
- > SPTR Enter state pass-through activity
 - USAS COB on Sept. 26, 2019
 - Web apps COB on Sept. 28, 2019
 - Certify by COB on Sept. 28, 2019
- ➤ ONDSS Upload fluctuation analysis
- > Do NOT submit hard copy notes or AFR to CPA's Financial Reporting section

After Oct. 1, 2019:



- Management/Other Oversight Agencies
- > FMQuery reports include all relevant AFR entries
- Use note templates (available from the Reporting Requirements' website) for all applicable notes
- CPA's Financial Reporting section will perform the following:
 - Complete and certify the GR Reconciliation
 - Complete and certify the Note 2 web application (including Basis Conversion entries)
 - Complete and certify the Note 5 web application (including Basis Conversion entries)
 - Complete and certify the Note 8 web application
 - Complete and certify the ONDSS web application
 - Complete and certify the USAS Certification web application

Option 2



- > Agency is responsible for all required AFR submissions
 - Including basis conversion
 - Upload notes to ONDSS
 - Complete all other applicable AFR web applications
 - Complete USAS Certification web application by COB on Oct. 1, 2019
- ➤ No exceptions to report as a Full Reporting Agency
