I. Welcome (April Shapley)

- Roll call for phone participants.
- Quorum confirmed.

II. Production Update: Financials Support Requests (SRs)

- SR Summary Documentation (Chelsa Vinklarek)
  - User Group members were provided with a summary of all active SRs on the HR/Payroll system.
  - There were 156 active SRs and 92 were considered high.
  - There are currently no critical SRs.
- SR Trend Report (Chelsa Vinklarek)
  - During this reporting period there were 243 SRs opened and 223 were closed.
- Governance Approved Enhancements (Terry Wooten)
  - A spreadsheet of Governance Approved SRs was provided. Updates since the last meeting are identified with an asterisk (\*) and **bolded**.
    - SR 4876 – moved to *Pending Prod Migration*.
    - SR 7224 – moved to *In Work*.
- Required Maintenance (Terry Wooten)
  - User Group members were provided a list of Required Maintenance SRs. Updates since the last meeting are identified with an asterisk (\*) and **bolded**.
    - SR 7900 – moved to *In Work*.
    - SR 7936 – moved to *In Work*.

- SR 8000 – moved to *In Work*.

### III. PeopleTools Upgrade 8.55 (Steve Schiurring)

- The PeopleTools 8.55 upgrade was originally scheduled to go-live on March 20, 2017; however, this date has been indefinitely extended due to unexpected issues identified in Portal.
- During cutover weekend, many of the testers encountered an empty page upon logging in; links and buttons were not there.
- The cause of the issue was still unknown by 5:00 p.m. on March 18 so the go-live was delayed.
- Production environments were rolled back to 5:00 p.m. on March 17; however, the Maintenance (MNT) and Reporting (RPT) environments experienced some issues and those environments took longer to restore. They were unavailable the morning of March 20, 2017.
  - Many lessons were learned about recovery procedures as a result of this issue.
- Sandbox (SBX) will continue to be used as a test environment for agencies.
- UAT will be available again for image testing beginning June 5, 2017.
- The CAPPS Support Team will communicate the new go-live date as soon as it is known.

### IV. HX Data Conversion and Retention (Terry Wooten)

- User Group members were provided with the *HX Data Conversion and Retention* document.
  - The new USAS inbound processes use a new table (TX\_HX) which includes the same HX data currently stored in TX\_INTF\_HX\_TBL.
  - Some reports and public queries (including the AFR report) read TX\_INTF\_HX\_TBL.
    - These reports will be redirected to the new table.
  - Numerous private queries are pointed to TX\_INTF\_HX\_TBL and agencies will need to rewrite these queries to read the new table.
  - Not all of the data from X\_INTF\_HX\_TBL will be converted to TX\_HX.
    - The current Fiscal Year (FY) and the prior four FYs from TX\_INTF\_HX\_TBL will be converted to the new TX\_HX table.
    - A Fiscal Year End (FYE) purge process will delete all TX\_HX records less than current FY minus four years.
  - Agencies should make an effort to clear transactions held on the TX\_US\_HX\_RECYC table.
  - Recycled transactions effective dated within the current AY and two prior AYs will be maintained.
    - The archive process will be executed with these parameters at the end of each FY.

### V. Changing Commitment Control and Budget Definitions During FY (Terry Wooten)

- Budget definitions should not be changed during the FY as this will determine how roll-ups work.

- Changes should be made at FYE and only after conducting testing in a test environment.
- Agencies can request assistance by entering an SR in ASP.

#### VI. USAS Confidentiality Indicator (Terry Wooten)

- The ratio of transactions marked “confidential” increases after an agency deploys CAPPS.
- Agencies can choose to default all transactions as “confidential” but should be aware that it is their responsibility to ensure this is accurate. Transactions marked “confidential” must be justified.

#### VII. Batch Consolidation Update (Terry Wooten)

- The goal of the CAPPS Support Team is to create a statewide batch consolidation model with PeopleSoft-delivered processes.
- Processing time will be more efficient if more agencies can consolidate the batch run.
- The CAPPS Support Team is meeting with agencies to understand any issues with the proposed schedule.
- UAT for Financials is scheduled to begin June 5, 2017.
- The go-live for the new batch schedule is July 28, 2017.

#### VIII. Project Update: Financials Deployment FY17 (Pete Marcell)

- Deploying agencies: COA 1- 14, CPRIT, OCFW, SCJC, TCCA, THECB, TSC, TSL and TSLAC.
- On track for go-live September 1, 2017.
- The “soft” go-live is on track for August 14, 2017.
- Configuration is nearly complete and some prototype sessions are still needed with agencies.
- All Functional Design Documents (FDDs) and Technical Design Documents (TDDs) are complete.
- Mock 1 conversion was completed with no errors.
- Conversion begin April 3, 2017.
- UAT begins June 5 through July 28, 2017.
