- I. Welcome (Chelsa Vinklarek)
 - Roll call for phone participants.
 - Quorum confirmed.

- II. Production Update: Financials Support Requests (SRs)
 - SR Summary Documentation (Chelsa Vinklarek)

- Note: beginning next month, the SR Summary/Trend Report will reflect data from the previous calendar month. Currently, the report represents data between UG meetings and the timing is not always consistent.
- User Group members were provided with a summary of all active SRs on the HR/Payroll system.
- There were 427 active SRs and 175 were considered high.
- There are currently no critical SRs.
- SR Trend Report (Chelsa Vinklarek)
 - The date of this report is August 1, 2017.
 - The Trend chart shows two entries for July: the first column shows the data from the previous reporting period; the second column shows the data from the end of July (July 27 – 31) that was not included in the previous report.
 - For the month of July (in total), there were 241 SRs opened and 196 closed.
- Governance Approved Enhancements (Chelsa Vinklarek)
 - A spreadsheet of Governance Approved SRs was provided. Updates since the last meeting are identified with an asterisk (*) and **bolded**.
 - SR 4646 – moved to *Pending Prod Approval*.
 - SR 4007 – moved to *Pending Prod Approval*.
 - SR 7520 – moved to *Complete*. This SR went to production on June 24 but there was an issue updating the ASP ticket. SR status is now updated.
 - SR 7519 – moved to *On Hold*. This SR relates to a report for Texas State Library and Archives (TSLAC). The agency may no longer need this report. SR is on hold while the request is being reviewed. The CAPPs Support Team may send this SR back through Governance with the recommendation to reject/close.
- Required Maintenance (Chelsa Vinklarek/Terry Wooten)
 - User Group members were provided a list of Required Maintenance SRs. Updates since the last meeting are identified with an asterisk (*) and **bolded**.
 - SR 7645 – moved to *Pending Prod Approval*.
 - SR 7936 – moved to *Complete*.

III. Project Update: Financials Deployment FY17 (Pete Marcell)

- Deploying agencies: COA 1 – 14, CPRIT, OCFW, SCJC, TCCA, THECB, TSC, TSL, and TSLAC.
- On track for go-live on September 1, 2017.
 - One agency at risk of delay but deployment team believes it will be able to implement on target.
- Many project phases have been completed since the last User Group meeting. The remaining project phases are all green/on track.
- The Deployment phase is on track and the soft go-live went well. Agencies are staging requisitions/Purchase Orders (POs) and loading vendors. Assets will be loaded next week.

IV. Miscellaneous

- CAPPS was briefly unavailable on August 16, 2017.
 - The CAPPS Support Team identified a database issue but is still performing analysis.
 - Additional information will be provided once the Root Cause Analysis (RCA) is completed.
- Some agencies stated that the General Ledger (GL) screen appears smaller than it used to be and is not as helpful for users.
 - The smaller screen is due to the new image upgrade.
 - An SR has been opened for this issue and is being researched.
 - The issue occurs in multiple browsers so it may be related to personalization setup.
- Since migration, table names have changed on the Batch Interface reports.
 - Agencies are now directed to Statewide Reports but are not getting the desired results.
 - One batch did not migrate on August 10, 2017. Tony Martin has discussed the issue with the CAPPS Team and they believe it is related to a workaround process that removed header lines at the time.
- The biannual CAPPS Governance representation vote is planned for next month.
 - CAPPS agency CFOs will receive an email from April Shapley with details.
- Next month's User Group meeting include dashboards for the FY18 deploying agencies.
