### Ladies and Gentlemen:

We are pleased to present you with the latest information on the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) project for Texas state government, in accordance with Section 2101.040 of the Texas Government Code. Texas is ever closer to delivering the functionality required by House Bill 3106, 80th Legislature, Regular Session, with a modern and secure statewide solution to the state's accounting and HR/payroll needs. The enclosed *Report on the Implementation of the Centralized Accounting and Payroll/Personnel System* (Comptroller Rider 15) includes project costs, a complete listing of deployed agencies, references to future implementations, and notes about other system impacts.

Our statewide ERP solution, the Centralized Accounting and Payroll/Personnel System (CAPPS), delivers Texas government an integrated statewide system to replace a variety of aging legacy systems. CAPPS provides benefits that save time, improve transparency and customer service, enhance security, and allow for economies of scale that provide increased efficiency and reduced cost to the state. A statewide ERP solution returns exceptional value to state agencies, the Legislature, oversight agencies and the public.

As detailed in the enclosure, the Comptroller's office has deployed CAPPS to 118 state agencies since fiscal 2012. Including the five CAPPS Hub implementations and with our deployment plan for fiscal 2025 projects, as of Sept. 1, 2025, CAPPS will be used by 123 agencies. CAPPS will account for 99.8 percent of all state agency spending and 75 percent of all full-time employees of state agencies, excluding employees at institutions of higher education and some legislative agencies. Contingent on legislative appropriations, the anticipated completion date of CAPPS deployments is Sept. 1, 2026.

Since our last reporting, CAPPS successfully implemented numerous improvements to core system functionality and accomplished significant enhancements including improved recording and reporting of prior state service and increased security protections. Additionally, we performed our annual software upgrade to the core system to take advantage of new functionality while ensuring vendor support of the software.

On behalf of the CAPPS team, thank you for your support of this key initiative. State funds allocated to the ongoing CAPPS statewide deployment effort will continue to provide a centralized, secure source for the state's financials and HR/payroll information. # Report on the Implementation of the Centralized Accounting and Payroll/Personnel System

### Comptroller rider 15 (d)

Identification of information technology systems which have retired as a result of implementation of CAPPS, including any cost savings resulting from those systems' retirements, and those which are expected to retire in the current fiscal year.

The Comptroller's office continues to evaluate the impact of deploying CAPPS as described above.

Analysis of the mainframe HR/Payroll systems, which include the Uniform Statewide Payroll/Personnel System (USPS), the Human Resource information System (HRIS) and the Standardized Payroll/Personnel Reporting System (SPRS) determined that, while they are separate systems, the interdependency for processing would make decommissioning one system at a time difficult and could cause a great amount of future rework. All agencies that were reliant on USPS for transactional processing have now been deployed on CAPPS. The next steps are to begin a methodical approach to process payroll independently of SPRS. Although in progress, that project cannot be completed until the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) is deployed on CAPPS HR/Payroll. That deployment is currently scheduled for completion in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of FY26.

Uniform Statewide Accounting System (USAS) was implemented in 1993 and Texas Identification Number System (TINS) was implemented in 1989. These applications utilize the Mainframe xOS2.5 platform and the COBOL/Natural programing languages. It is necessary to migrate these applications to a more sustainable platform. That system, the Centralized Accounting and Payroll/Personnel System (CAPPS) State of Texas Accounting and Reporting Resource (STARR) system, will include core USAS/TINS functionality used by state agencies and institutions of higher education. That multi-year effort is detailed in CPA's recent Business Case submission to the Quality Assurance Team (CAPPS STARR Project).
